Representative Ruff moved and Representative Klein seconded a conceptual motion to provide for license revocation or suspension of new license and denial of license if new application if in violation of that act.. The motion was withdrawn.

After discussion, Representative Ruff and Representative Klein withdrew their motion and second.

Chairman Boston appointed Representatives Klein, Lloyd and staff to work on the language of revocation, suspension or denial and the committee would continue on this at the next meeting that deals with <u>HB 2159</u>.
