HB 2010 DEPARTMENT OF VEHICLES - OPEN RECORDS ACT

Betty McBride, Director, Division of Vehicles proposed changes regarding language to maintain confidentiality of records, clarifying intent regarding copies of contract and minimum and maximum penalties for violations of provisions of contract and length of time required to maintain records. These provisions will apply if marketing as proposed is adopted. Interested parties agreed to these changes.

Senator Karr moved to adopt the amendments from the Polk and INK compromise. Senator Gilstrap seconded the motion. Motion carried. Senator Harrington moved to conceptually adopt the amendments offered by Director, Division of Vehicles. Senator Karr seconded the motion. Motion carried. Senator Tyson moved to technically amend p.2, line 26. to conform to language in rest of bill. Senator Karr seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Discussed implications of this bill re "opt in - opt out." Members also considered the broadcasters and print media's request to be included in exemptions - those allowed access to records. They are currently challenging their exclusion under Federal Law.

<u>Senator Gilstrap moved to recommend</u> <u>Amended HB 2010</u> favorable for passage. <u>Senator Karr seconded the motion</u>. <u>Motion carried</u>. Senators Huelskamp and Salmans wished to be recorded as voting "NO." Senator Vidricksen will carry the bill.

<u>HB 2188</u> <u>WILDLIFE & PARKS - LONG TERM LEASES - IMPROVEMENTS & DEVELOPMENT</u>

Members agreed this bill is not meant to deal with extensive lake resort development. Senator Karr moved to amend section (c) into the bill to clarify that family oriented lodging does not include development of lake resorts. Senator Gilstrap seconded the motion. Motion carried. Senator Karr moved to recommend Amended HB 2188 favorable for passage. Senator Tyson seconded the motion. Motion carried. Senator Karr will carry the bill.
