## HB 2731 - Municipalities; urban renewal

Representative Nancy L. Kirk testified in support of HB 2731 stating current law permits cities to determine when it is too costly to rehabilitate a property based on the assessed value. HB 2731 changes wording from assessed value to replacement costs ensuring like properties are treated the same, and that location in the community does not inadvertently discriminate against lower income areas.
