Chairman Tanner requested the subcommittee report on **SB 129**. Representative Bethel gave the subcommittee report with the amendment on page 37 line 34 by inserting language about the site of service after consultation with the parent or guardian of the child. Representative Bethel made a motion to pass the subcommittee report and the bill out favorably. Chairman Tanner said that the subcommittee report does not require a second and would like to look at the bill and subcommittee report separately. (Attachment 1)

Representative Storm made a motion to add to the committee's definition that is contained in the new Federal Regulation on IDEA concerning step parent. Representative Flaharty seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Representative Bethel made a motion to approve the sub committee report. The motion carried.

Representative Bethel made a motion to report **SB 129** favorably for passage, as amended. Representative Crow seconded. The motion carried. Representative Thimmesch, Representative O'Connor, Representative Faber recorded as voting no.

Discussion on **SB 171** School Finance - Comparison of Current Law, as approved by the Senate and a proposed plan (L9940).

Listed below is a summary of **SB 171** as approved by the Senate

- Decreases correlation weighting from 1,750 to 1,725
- Increase base state aid per pupil from \$3,720 to \$3,770
- Includes \$1,000,000 for four-year-old-at-risk preschool student.
- Increases at-risk weighting from 8.0 percent to 9.0 percent.'
- Counts four-year-old at-risk children in addition to regular enrollment count.

Listed below is a summary of a proposed school finance plan (L9940)

- Same as **SB 171**, as approved by Senate except:
- Amends enrollment count by adding three-year average to current law
- Grants a minimum enrollment count of 100 students
- Increase base state aid per pupil from \$3,720 to \$3,787 (\$17.00 above the Senate plan)

The last two factors is about 12.8 million dollars. (Attachment 2)

Dale Dennis, also supplied the committee with a computer printout (L9941) which compares three different school finance proposals with column explanations. (Attachment 3)

Chairman Tanner asked the committee to review the information and that we will look at different issues that will affect the school finance formula.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:55 a.m.

Re: Report of Subcommittee

On March 11, House Education Committee Chairman, Representative Tanner, appointed the Subcommittee whose members were Representatives Bob Bethell (chair), Marti Crow, Henry Helgerson, Bill Mason, Kay O'Connor, and Sue Storm, and assigned the Subcommittee S.B. 129 and related special education matters.

The Subcommittee held four meetings (March 15, 16, 17, and 18) in carrying out its assignment. Testimony was received from the State Department of Education; Kansas Catholic Conference; Kansas Association of School Boards, Kansas Gifted, Talented, and Creative (KGTC); Shawnee Mission Association for the Gifted (SMAG); Families Together; Kansas Council on Developmental Disabilities; Wichita Public Schools; and Kansas Advocacy and Protective Services. Given time constraints and other factors, the Subcommittee decided to focus its attention on the issues contained in S.B. 129.

In general, the Subcommittee found broad-based, though not totally enthusiastic support for S.B. 129 in its current form, except for sections 39, 40, and 41, the "auxiliary services" statutes, which were more contentious.

As a result of its deliberations, the Subcommittee recommends to the House Education Committee that S.B. 129 be recommended to the House for passage with the addition of one amendment.


The Subcommittee recommends the bill be amended on page 37 in line 34 after the word ~~district.~~, by adding the following sentence:

The site for the provision of special education services under this section for an exceptional child shall be determined by the school district after consultation with the parent or guardian of the child and with officials of the private, nonprofit elementary or secondary school.

The Subcommittee found there to be confusion in the current language of the bill as to the authority for determining the location at which special education services were to be

provided to a nonpublic school student. This amendment clarifies that a school district which is responding to the request by a parent for special education services for a child who resides in the school district retains authority to determine the site for the provision of these services—whether it be in the nonpublic school or in the public schools of the district. This decision, however, can be reached only after consultation with the child's parent and with officials of the nonpublic school.

SUBJECT: School Finance--Comparison of Current Law, Senate Bill 171, as approved by the Senate, and a Proposed Plan

Attached is a computer printout (L9940) which shows the 1999-2000 general fund budget under current law, Senate Bill 171, as approved by the Senate, and a proposed plan. Please review the column explanation carefully. This information has been provided in county order.

Listed below is a summary of **Senate Bill 171, as approved by the Senate**

- Decreases correlation weighting from 1,750 to 1,725
- Increase base state aid per pupil from \$3,720 to \$3,770
- Includes \$1,000,000 for four-year-old at-risk preschool students. This is a permissive program and such students would be counted at .5 similar to the counting of kindergarten students under current law. This increases the number of students to 1,794.
- Increases at-risk weighting from 8.0 percent to 9.0 percent.
- Counts four-year-old at-risk children in addition to regular enrollment count

Listed below is a summary of **a proposed school finance plan**.

- Same as Senate Bill 171, as approved by Senate except:
- Amends enrollment count by adding three-year average to current law
- Grants a minimum enrollment count of 100 students.
- Increase base state aid per pupil from \$3,720 to \$3,787.
