The Joint House and Senate Education Committees, Chaired by Representative Tanner and Senator Lawrence, met for a presentation by the Midwestern Higher Education Commission. Senator Lawrence called the meeting to order and asked Senator Oleen to introduce the Commission.

Jerry Blakemore, president, thanked the committee and the people of Kansas for the hospitality. He stated the purpose of the Compact is to advance Midwestern higher education through interstate cooperation and resource sharing. The Commission is the governing body of the Compact, and is comprised of five appointees from each member state. Three Commissioners are appointed by each state's governor, and two are appointed by the state's legislative leadership. the Commission meets twice annually to establish priorities and oversee the programs of the Compact.

- 3. Midwest Telecommunications Alliance
- 4. Midwest Student Exchange Program
- 5. Regional Master Property Program
- 6. Natural Gas Program

Phillip Sirotkin, spoke on the goals and some of the programs. The Commission's goals are to:

- Enhance productivity through reductions in administrative costs
- Encourage student access, completion, and affordability
- Facilitate public policy analysis and information exchange
- Foster regional academic cooperation and services
- · Promote quality educational programs
- Encourage innovation in the delivery of educational services.

The meeting was opened for questions and discussion.
