Senator Biggs reviewed the proposed amendments to <u>SB 278-cigarettes and tobacco products; relating to samples</u> that had been given previously to committee members. <u>Senator Jones moved that the amendments be adopted and that SB 278 be favorably recommended as amended to the full Senate. <u>Senator Biggs seconded the motion</u>. The motion carried.</u>

Chairman Oleen referred to proposed amendments to <u>SB 331- establishing the Kansas historical marker</u> committee that had previously been distributed to all members. Senator Oleen noted that the interested parties could proceed without legislation. <u>Senator Becker moved that the bill be recommended unfavorably. Senator Harrington seconded the motion.</u> The motion carried.

Chairman Oleen called for a motion on <u>SB 239- cigarettes and tobacco products</u>; relating to the sale and <u>distribution thereof</u> and <u>SB 279-the sale or distribution of tobacco products</u>; amending K.S.A. 79-3371. Senator Biggs moved that the bills be recommended unfavorably. Senator Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried.
