Chairman Oleen stated that staff had prepared an balloon with amendment to **SB 317-Paternity; revocation of acknowledgment; time limit** which addressed the issues that were brought up at the hearing. Senator Gooch moved to favorably report **SB317** as amended to the full Senate. Senator Harrington seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Chairman Oleen noted that an amendment to <u>HB 2040</u> had been prepared by legislative staff to address concerns expressed by opponents to the original bill and to the bill as amended by the house. Theresa Kiernan stated that the bill as amended includes inflatable rides. After discussion by the committee <u>Senator Vratil moved to amend the bill to reduce the mandatory liability insurance from \$1 million to \$500,000 for government entities which includes cities, counties and municipalities. Senator Harrington seconded the <u>motion.</u> Senator Oleen asked for discussion on the amendment and members felt that all parties, including individual owners and government entities should be required to have the same insurance coverage. <u>After committee discussion Senator Vratil agreed to change the amendment to require \$500,000 liability insurance for all owners and operators. Senator Harrington agreed to the change. The motion carried.</u></u>

Senator Vratil moved to favorably report **HB 2040** as amended to the full Senate. Senator Jones seconded the motion. The motion carried
