BILL INTRODUCTIONS

Senator Feleciano moved to introduce a bill which would extend the "drug-free zone" around schools. It would also cover the sale of illegal drugs to a woman the offender knows or should have known to be pregnant, Senator Bond seconded. Carried.

Senator Bond moved to introduce clean-up legislation of the statute addressing criminal prosecution of juvenile traffic offenders, Senator Vratil seconded. Carried.

Senator Feleciano moved to introduce a bill which would make exempt from local law enforcement drug testing, train engineers who have been involved in a train accident and who operate under federal law, Senator Donovan seconded. Carried

Senator Feleciano moved to introduce a bill which would transfer municipal courts to the jurisdiction of the Supreme Court, Senator Donovan seconded. Carried.
