Dear Secretary Adams:

We write in support of your Department's efforts to persuade the United States Environmental Protection Agency to use its authority under Section 18 of the Federal Food Quality Protection Act to permit the special use of Vista (fluroxyltyr) blended with Remedy (triclopyr ester) to combat sericea lespedeza in pastureland.

As you know, sericea lespedeza is a noxious weed in Kansas. It is a serious threat to our prairie ecosystems, and it is a serious threat to livestock grazing in those areas it infests. Unfortunately, the area of infestation in our state continues to grow.

Kansas farmers and ranchers are committed to fighting the spread of sericea lespedeza, but the chemical treatment methods currently available are prohibitively expensive. Permitting the use of Vista blended with Remedy would tend to reduce the cost of treatment. For example, the current average per-acre price of treatment with Remedy alone has been estimated at \$15.52. With a Vista/Remedy blend, it has been estimated that the cost of treatment could fall to \$9.50 per acre.

Thank you for your efforts in this regard. If the members of the House Agriculture Committee can be of further assistance in obtaining this Section 18 special use authority, please let us know.
