MINUTES OF THE e-GOVERNMENT COMMITTEE.

The meeting was called to order by Chairperson Deena Horst at 3:41 p.m. on February 6, 2001, in Room 654-S of the Landon Building.

Robert Knapp, President of the Kansas Information Consortium, serves as the the General Manager for the Information Network of Kansas (INK). Mr. Knapp reviewed the acronyms to familiarize committee members with the organization: (INK) Information Network of Kansas, (KIC) Kansas Information Consortium and (NIC) National Information Consortium. As of today, the site supports over 200,000 pages of information. Ninety Percent (90%) of this information is provided free to Kansas citizens. Through accessKansas, there have been nearly 250 applications and several hundred Web sites developed without any governmental appropriations. (Attachments 1 and 2)

A few of the key applications developed over the past nine years include:

- Online Property Tax Payment. This application recently was provided to over 22 counties for citizens to make their tax payments online.
- Online Hunting and Fishing License Purchases/Boat Registration Renewal.
- Lobbyist-in-a-Box and Legislative Bill Tracking.

("Assessing e-Government: The Internet, Democracy and Service Delivery by State and Federal Governments".) Mr. Knapp noted that Kansas was profiled in the Brown University study, for its excellence in government.

A few Kansas rankings to note:

- #1 in the percentage of web sites showing security policy.
- #4 in the percentage of web sites with privacy features.
- #6 in the overall ranking.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:00 p.m. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, February 8, 2001, at 3:30 p.m. in Room 526-S.

Madame Chairwoman and Members of the Committee,

I appreciate the opportunity to come before you today. As part of this testimony there is a multitude of information we can discuss and of which I believe you would have an interest. In the interest of time today, I will try and provide you with an overview of the following areas:

- 1. My role and responsibilities;
- accessKansas and the participating entities as of today and a brief history of the organizations;
- 3. An overview of solutions including some of the key applications, development activities and national recognition recognized by the State of Kansas and the Information Network of Kansas;
- 4. And a live portal overview and case example

I know this sounds like a great deal of information, and no one will ever accuse me of brevity, but I do promise you that I will be providing you with short snippets of this information and be more than willing to return with further information on any of these issues should you desire it.

A definition of acronyms is probably appropriate before we get started to ensure we are all on a level setting before we discuss each of these elements.

INK – Information Network of Kansas, Inc. – state "quasi-agency" created through KSA 74–9303 to provide electronic services and access to the citizens, businesses, and government employees of the State of Kansas.

 ${f KIC}$ – Kansas Information Consortium – the private partner selected by INK and the State of Kansas to fulfill the role of Network Manager for the portal providing electronic services.

NIC – National Information Consortium – the parent organization of the Kansas Information Consortium, recognized as one of the premier providers of eGovernment services throughout the world. NIC manages transactions for hundreds of state & local agencies that serve more than 43 million people in the United States. accessKansas – the branded identity of the State of Kansas Internet Web portal.

Before starting, I would like to clarify my role – especially in relation to today's testimony.



The initiative for self-funded electronic government services for governmental entities began when the State of Kansas issued a Request for Proposal seeking a private partner who could design, implement and operate the Information Network of Kansas (INK), which as you may know is a self-funding e-government operation that sought to deliver services to citizens and businesses electronically. The Information Network of Kansas organization exemplified the public private partnership through the Governor appointments of five public sector board members and five private sector members to oversee the development of eGovernment services for the State of Kansas. These services were to be provided through no government appropriation. A group of Kansas technology executives created the Kansas Information Consortium (KIC) specifically to provide this solution for the State of Kansas. I have included an article written in 1995 in Attachment A entitled, INK: The Information Network of Kansas – A Model for Public Access through Public-Private Partnerships that really Works that will provide you with a detailed description of how this partnership was created and its first few years of inception prior to the extensive use of the Internet.

Since August 2000, I have served as the president of the Kansas Information Consortium in the role of the General Manager for the Information Network of Kansas. My primary responsibility is the daily operational management and interface with the State of Kansas for its eGovernment solutions portal. This responsibility ranges from management of a team of marketing, development, design and content personnel who provide the project management, web design and development of eGovernment applications to other responsibilities including the active participation in state technology committees, such as ITASK, ITAB, and ITEC representing INK and its ongoing technology activities in the state.

I am here today representing the Kansas Information Consortium as the Network Manager for the Information Network of Kansas. INK, as the oversight authority for the Network Manager, has a set of objectives and goals. It is my organization's hope and mission that we represent the same vision, goals and objectives of INK and ultimately the State of Kansas government and its citizenry. I know that simply through the establishment of this partnership with INK and the State of Kansas, KIC has a tremendous presence and accountability for delivering the mission of INK. In its tactical form this delivery comes through the newly branded accessKansas (www.accessKansas.org), the State of Kansas Internet portal for eGovernment solutions.

I would highly encourage you to receive direct testimony from the Information Network of Kansas Board of Directors as this committee continues to pursue the success of eGovernment in Kansas. The history and role that the INK organization has played over the last nine years has been instrumental in delivering a state currently ranked 2nd in the United States in the latest Digital State survey performed by Government Technology Magazine. The foresight of then Secretary of State and now Governor Bill Graves, in conjunction with the Kansas legislature, defined INK and created a visionary model for eGovernment before anyone even knew how to spell eGovernment and certainly prior to anyone knowing what Yahoo, URL, eBay, and the Internet was. The State of Kansas was the birthplace of eGovernment and nine years later the way that state government portrays itself is even more important. The way



individuals interact with government has changed dramatically over the past nine years and INK has been instrumental in implementing that change. The online services INK offers through the portal has altered the way many individuals do business with government. The recent introduction of the redesigned web portal for the State of Kansas, branded as accessKansas, will take citizens to the next level of eGovernment, promising to be the ultimate online source for information and services.

As allowed for under current statute KSA 74-9303, KIC was awarded the contract as the Information Network of Kansas Network Manager in 1991 by the State of Kansas. KIC later became a subsidiary of the National Information Consortium, Inc.. The Information Network of Kansas is a quasi-agency dedicated to the mission of providing a public service to the citizens and businesses of Kansas by increasing accessibility to public information and other useful information services through electronic means; and to provide such public services without increasing the tax burden on the citizens of Kansas.

Through the remainder of this presentation I will use accessKansas to reference the partnership between the State of Kansas and KIC. This will include the employees and personnel of KIC who have been given the opportunity to provide services to the state agencies and entities of the state of Kansas. Where appropriate and for clarification, I will try and make distinctions between INK and KIC.

Now having provided a brief overview of the entities involved and hopefully providing you with some insight to the history of this partnership, let me now focus on the solutions, the actual end result of all of these efforts.

SOLUTIONS OVERVIEW

A portal is defined as an approach or entrance; the whole architectural composition surrounding and including a doorway. Just as a portal is the main focus and point of entry for structural architecture, it is the same for information architecture. Many people ask is there a difference between a Portal and a Web site? A portal is a vertical branch of the Web site family tree. The natural progression of a Web site has grown from basic informational brochure-ware to a totally immersive online solution. A portal takes the Web site to the next level – the next generation of service, information and convenience – it becomes the total user experience.

To illustrate this concept further, think of a Portal as an electronic neighborhood with all the services individuals need to perform their daily tasks efficiently. The neighborhood is made up of established residents and those who are visiting. It also contains many storefronts where individuals can shop and conduct business. What neighborhood would be complete without educational institutions such as schools and libraries? There are electronic curb cuts to allow access to the electronic and information technologies to all individuals, with or without disabilities. This neighborhood is patrolled for safety and privacy. It is also a place where people can express their individuality by customizing their personal space.



accessKansas, the State of Kansas Web portal that the network has developed and continually enhanced over time, is an entry point, a neighborhood, a personality, and an electronic welcome mat to all who enter. A state government portal belongs to the people of the state, as well as, the agencies, boards, commissions and committees that make it work. The concept behind the accessKansas portal is simple; allow individuals the most informative, intuitive, online government solution. Citizens and businesses will identify with the portal and rely on it to provide information and services. It will expand upon the expertise and trust that INK has established with its citizenry and provide an environment conducive to the complete user experience.

The accessKansas portal is a service-oriented electronic system, which enables users to interact with government in an efficient manner. The portal is a user-centric environment committed to the complete user experience for three targeted audiences – citizens, businesses and government employees. It will deliver information, services and transactions in a user-friendly architecture. Designed with regard to usability and accessibility standards of the highest level, the portal meets all navigation requirements currently measured. Over time, the scope of the portal will evolve to introduce new technologies that will benefit governmental partners and end users.

As of today, the site supports over 200,000 pages of information. 90% of this information is provided free to the citizens. Through accessKansas, there have been nearly 250 applications and several hundred Web sites developed without any governmental appropriations. A few of the key applications developed over the past nine years include:

Corporations Searches and Uniform Commercial Code Searches providing the capability to search and order Corporation Letters of Good Standing and Certificates of Good Standing through the Secretary of State.

Motor Vehicle Records Search allowing legally authorized users, such as insurance agents, to obtain Driver's License Records, Vehicle Titles, Registrations and Lien Records.

Online Property Tax Payment This application recently was provided to over 22 counties for citizens to make their tax payments online.

Kansas District Courts Records Online Search allowing citizens online access to four counties in Kansas and the ability to retrieve court documents in conjunction with the Newly Filed Cases Search application providing access to Civil Court Case Search, Civil Answer Docket, Criminal Case Search, Marriage Number Search and more.



Introduction

This site was created to give taxpayers the opportunity to make property tax payments online. The accepted payment method is <u>Electronic Check</u>. There is a \$1.00 processing fee assessed for each tax bill paid online.

Materials Needed

Access to your account involves entering information from your tax statement. This helps ensure your <u>privacy</u>. Please have it handy before you proceed.

Who Can Use Online Tax Payment?

There are some cases where individuals are not eligible to use the online tax payment process at this time. Please review the following exceptions before proceeding:

- Accounts with a prior tax year delinquency are ineligible. Please contact your <u>County Treasurer's office</u> for more information.
- Accounts that are in dispute or protest are ineligible. Please contact your <u>County</u> <u>Treasurer's office</u> for more information.
- In the case of international payments, funds must be drawn on a U.S. bank account.


