The Chairperson announced the meeting was called to consider gutting <u>Sub SB 584 - Grants</u> <u>institutional license in particular circumstance</u> which authorizes the granting of a license to practice medicine and surgery to a specific individual who met the requirements set out in the statute. This would remove <u>Sub SB 584</u> language and replace with the Senate version of <u>HB 2315 - Licensure of occupational therapists</u> as amended by Senate Committee of the Whole.

HB 2315 was altered by the Senate and this will offer a clean bill. This will give the Senate one more chance to work HB 2315 by itself.

The Chairperson asked if there was a motion to replace **Sub SB 584** with **HB 2315**?
