The Chairman stated this would be a continuation of hearing on SB 66 - Title insurance; prohibiting certain actions. SB 66 was somewhat of a contentious bill and there was a compromise added to the bill that was satisfactory to both the realtors and title companies.

Bill Yanek, Director of Governmental Relations, Kansas Association of Realtors, stated they do support SB 66 as amended with all the technical and non-technical amendments. There is one additional change from the amendments requested at the earlier hearing on March 16. On Page 8, line 16, replace "six" with "twelve".

John Peterson, representing the Kansas Land Title Association, stated this was a compromise. We urge your support for this amendment as it is written and pass it out on the House floor.

Representative Grant moved and Representative Swenson seconded to adopt the balloon and include the technical amendments. The motion carried.

Representative Humerickhouse asked if the Insurance Department would be able to regulate.

Marty Hazen, Kansas Insurance Department, was in the audience and stated the Department felt this was a good bill and they would not have a problem with the regulation.

Representative Grant moved and Representative Lane seconded to move SB 66 out favorably as amended. The motion carried.

The Chairman announced there would not be a meeting on Monday, March 22 and this might be the last meeting this year. The Chairman thanked the committee for their hard work.
