During my tenure in Washington DC as a Congressional Fellow many of the issues that I worked on were controversial, especially in mid-year when the committee chair decided to run for the Senate. At that time everything became contentious. One of the most controversial issues was what do you do with historic shipwrecks. I was in charge of the hearings and legislation. Mel Fischer had found the Atocha and was on Johnny Carson getting people to write and call in and I had him lined up to testify. Then Bob Ballard found the Titanic and I brought him in to testify on the opposite side. Every major news channel covered that hearing. This is just one of the few issues that came up during that period. During this time, I was identified both individually in public with the issue and as a member of the staff.

During the past 5 years or so I have testified numerous time before the House Utilities Committee on renewable energy and done briefings for the members on different issues relating to renewable energy such as policies other states have in place.

I am a generalist with a strong grounding in technology. For the past 20 years, in addition to managing technology research, I have been working to communicate technology to non-scientists. I am heavily involved in both the life sciences and in energy. Our work in developing a plastic that is 50% straw has us interfacing with the agricultural community. The company I own represents the type of industry that has been identified by the state as desirable for the state's economy. We are a high tech industry with high paying jobs. Most of our new product development work is for the biomedical community. I hope that my diverse background can support the activities of Kansas Inc.

Agro-Plastics received a start-up grant from the Department of Commerce to develop a technology to make a plastic that contains 50% wheat straw.
