MINUTES OF THE SENATE EDUCATION COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Jean Schodorf at 1:35 p.m. on January 25, 2005, in Room 123-S of the Capitol.

Senator Schodorf called upon Jim Hays, Kansas Association of School Boards (KASB) for a report on school district sharing of administrators and services. Mr. Hays distributed copies of his report which included charts with data provided by the State Department of Education and by KASB. (Attachment 1) After discussing statistics on page one of the report regarding USD certified employees for school years 2000-01 through 2003-04, he pointed out that the figures show where cuts were necessary in order to make increases in other areas. He noted that changes in student needs have increased the expectations of the system. He followed with a discussion of a KASB survey in which superintendents were asked to identify their "other duties." He pointed out that the superintendents of the smaller school districts reported more "other duties." He went on to discuss the most common USD cooperative arrangements (interlocal, special education, regional service center, and ITV network), calling attention to a list USDs by descending order of enrollment which showed the type of cooperative used by each district. He noted that most school districts are involved in some kind of cooperative arrangement. He followed with a discussion of other related issues about cooperation which include combined activities, Greenbush (Southeast Kansas Educational Service Center), and KASB services. Mr. Hays left a copy of the KASB school district organization handbook entitled "Cooperative Agreements, Consolidations, Closing School Buildings, and Transfer of Territory" with Senator Schodorf on permanent loan to be available to committee members upon request. In addition, he left a copy of the Greenbush 2004 Annual Report.

Senator Schodorf called upon Carolyn Rampey, Kansas Legislative Research Department, for an overview of voluntary incentives for school districts to consolidate. Ms. Rampey explained that the statute addresses the situation where two school districts combine and, because they are declining in enrollment, their combined budget is less than what the individual budget was for the prior year. She explained that, in order to encourage consolidation, the Legislature provided an incentive. When two districts combine, they can get for their budget, in the year that they combine, the budget that the individual districts had the year before, plus, for the next two years they get to choose the higher of the prior year's budget or what they would get under the formula. In 2002, the Legislature put a deadline on the incentive. If the districts consolidated by July 1, 2004, they would get three successive years (the prior year budget for the two individual districts for the year they consolidated added together plus the next three years. Last year, the Legislature knew that there were districts which were in the process of consolidation. Because it takes months to consolidate, those districts would miss the July 1, 2004, deadline. Therefore, the Legislature extended the deadline to July 1, 2005. Under the 2005 deadline, in the year of consolidation, the districts can get two budgets combined for the prior year plus the for next two successive years the higher of either what the district got the year before or what it would get under the formula.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:30 p.m.

Report on School Districts' Sharing of Administration and Services before the Senate Committee on Education

Senator Schodorf, Members of the Committee. My name is Jim Hays and I work for the Kansas Association of School Boards. Thank you for the opportunity to appear here today and discuss some information relative to the issue of cooperative ventures among Kansas school districts. I will proceed through this material in the order that it is presented in this booklet and would be glad to discuss each issue or section of the information as we talk about it, or wait and respond to questions at the end.

In summary, Kansas had 302 Unified School Districts last year, operating 1,396 school buildings spread over the 82,016 square miles of our state. These schools educated 440,822.3 FTE students last year, and employed a total of 39,074.5 FTE certified personnel in all aspects of those students' education.

For a long time in Kansas, school boards and administrators have recognized the value of doing many things within their educational programs in a cooperative way. Our median enrollment school district had 532.2 FTE students last year. Without cooperation among some or many districts over the years, integral parts of the educational process like staff development, special education and distance learning technology would never have been possible.

In discussing areas where districts cooperate with one another, it would be significantly easier and a much shorter presentation to attempt to identify areas where districts are NOT cooperating, where the "wheel" is being reinvented, and where new ideas and methods are being resisted. But due to the extreme financial pressures confronting virtually all districts over the past several years, it seems likely that every conceivable avenue of joint ventures has been explored by at least some clever administrator and board of education, somewhere.

Again, thank you for the opportunity to appear today and as we talk about the material presented here I would be happy to respond to any questions.

Other Related Issues about Cooperation

1. Combined activities: KSHSAA rules allow, under certain tightly controlled circumstances, for no more than 2 member high schools to field combined sports teams. According to the most recent information available from KSHSAA (email on January 21, 2005) the following number of combined teams exists in each of the following activities. (By definition, a combined team is 2 high schools, so multiplying each number by 2 would give you the number of high schools affected.)

2. Greenbush: The Southeast Kansas Educational Service Center, popularly known by its location as "Greenbush" is involved in so many cooperative ventures and offers cooperatively produced services to so many districts that a complete discussion of its efforts would take more time than is available to us here. A copy of the most recent Greenbush Annual Report is made available to the committee. If more in depth discussion of all of these examples of districts securing services more efficiently and effectively through Greenbush cooperative programs is desirable, I'm sure their representatives would be glad to appear before the committee.

3. Kansas Association of School Boards: KASB provides a number of services to its member boards of education that are examples of cooperative ventures in effectiveness and efficiency. 298 of the 301 USDs in Kansas are members of the association and thereby secure services such as advocacy, research, negotiations, written policy books, board member training seminars and school law. In addition, 320school districts, and other entities are members of the KASB Legal Assistance Fund, where they have established a formal attorney/client relationship with our legal staff and thereby secure specific legal services for their districts. Pooling arrangements operated by KASB include the workers' compensation insurance pool with 183 members and the natural gas pool (K-JUMP) with 106 members, where members secure these services more efficiently by working together.

The committee may be interested in reviewing a recent KASB publication, made available by our legal staff to member school districts. "Cooperative Agreements, Consolidations, Closing School Buildings and Transfer of Territory; a Guide for Kansas School Districts 2004." This publication outlines many specific examples of efforts at cooperation and emphasizes the legal aspects of how this cooperation should proceed.
