Senator Schodorf requested the introduction of a bill including the provisions of the Senate Education Plan for the 2005 Special Legislative Session. She noted that the plan would provide an additional \$160,000,000 in state aid for schools.

Senator Apple moved to introduce the bill, seconded by Senator Teichman. The motion carried.

Senator Schodorf requested the introduction of a bill which was sponsored by Senator Derek Schmidt. She explained that the bill would prohibit the closing of Kansas schools by the Supreme Court or a Special Master appointed by the Supreme Court should legislators not pass a measure during the 2005 Special Legislative Session in response to the Court's ruling that the Legislature must provide additional funding for Kansas public schools by July 1, 2005.

Senator Ostmeyer moved to introduce the bill, seconded by Senator Teichman. The motion carried.
