What Is SuperSAC?

Students, those most impacted by the many policy recommendations made each year by a school district's administration, are often times the group least involved in developing such policies. As part of the Wichita Public Schools' commitment to community engagement, Wichita Superintendent Winston Brooks created SuperSAC (Superintendent's Student Advisory Council). Now in its third year, SuperSAC was created to engage students in discussion about critical district issues and concerns that most directly impact them.

Modeled after a similar program in Portland (Oregon) Public Schools, SuperSAC consists of representatives from every high school (11) in the Wichita Public Schools. The group meets monthly throughout the year with Superintendent Winston Brooks to discuss issues that are of importance to students in our district. Topics have included food and vending in schools, budget and school finance, suspension and expulsion policies, school safety, high school reform, weighted grades, and district finals policies. Discussions also provide a venue for student feedback to the Wichita Board of Education (BOE). Highlights of these discussions are shared each month with BOE members in a report delivered to the Board directly by SuperSAC members.
