AN ACT supplementing the Kansas consumer protection code; concerning dissemination of electronic mail addresses; prohibiting certain acts 10 and providing remedies and penalties for violations. 11 12 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 13 Section 1. (a) A person sponsoring, arranging or conducting a con-14 ference, seminar or other meeting shall not disseminate any electronic 15 mail address received in the course of registration for such conference, 16 seminar or other meeting without the express authorization of the 17 18 registrant. (b) Violation of this section is a deceptive act or practice under the 19 provisions of the Kansas consumer protection act and shall be subject to 20 any and all enforcement provisions of the Kansas consumer protection 21 22 act.
