Senator Schodorf explained that a bill she sponsored, <u>SB 458</u> concerning the Criminal Street Gang Prevention Act, was not worked by the House Judiciary Committee; therefore a vehicle was needed for a conference. In addition, she noted that a bill sponsored by Senator Mike Peterson, <u>SB 366</u> amending the sentencing guidelines law to add a new aggravating factor when the crime involved more than one participant, was scheduled for debate in the House. She explained that <u>HB 2529</u> concerning grand juries was referred to the Senate Judiciary Committee, and the Chairman of the Judiciary Committee referred the bill to the Senate Education Committee to be used as a vehicle for <u>SB 458</u> and <u>SB 366</u>. She distributed copies of <u>SB 366</u> and <u>SB 458</u>.

Senator Teichman moved to delete the provisions in **HB 2529** and insert the Senate passed versions of **SB** 366 and **SB 458**, seconded by Senator Goodwin. The motion carried.
