Language offered for alternative language to SB 55:

K.S.A. 50-635 (b): The Kansas consumer protection act does not allow for a private cause of action or remedy against a licensed health care provider for causes of action for personal injury or death resulting, or alleged to have resulted, from medical negligence. For purposes of this subsection, "health care provider" shall have the same meaning as K.S.A. 65-4915(a)(1).
