## MINUTES OF THE HOUSE FEDERAL AND STATE AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Arlen Siegfreid at 12:30 P.M. on April 3, 2008, in Room 431 N of the Capitol.

Chairman Siegfreid called the meeting to order and recognized Representative Loganbill. Representative Loganbill moved to strike all language from SB 397 and place the contents of SB 677 into House Substitute for SB 397. Seconded by Representative Peterson, the motion carried.

Judy explained that this bill will provide for new technology to process documents more quickly. It would give identity protection and implement a way to check with other states for multiple driver's licenses being given to the same applicant and reduce fraud.

Representative Peterson moved House Substitute for SB 397 as amended favorable for passage. Seconded by Representative Loganbill, the motion carried.

The Chair opened discussion on <u>HB 2799</u> - Court of appeals judges appointed by governor, subject to senate confirmation; creating a court of appeals nominating commission to nominate three qualified persons; governor appoints any qualified persons.

Representative Kinzer moved to amend **HB 2799** to clarify the confirmation process of the Senate. The amendment was seconded by Representative Brown. Motion passed.

The Chair adjourned the meeting.
