Chairman Brungardt opened the confirmation hearing.

John Carmichael, Kansas Human Rights Commission

Mr. Carmichael appeared before the committee to answer questions on his appointment to the Kansas Human Rights Commission. (Attachment 1) The committee requested information from the appointment questionnaire form on the experience and affiliations page, and from letters and emails received from constituents. The committee was interested in the ideology and goals that Mr. Carmichael would bring to the commission and on certain topics of concern. Mr. Carmichael stated he did not have a private agenda against law enforcement.

The committee requested clarification on several questions on the appointment questionnaire. Mr. Carmichael was appointed to the commission in July of 2007 and started serving in August 2007. Due to the previous Chairman's unexpected resignation, Mr. Carmichael was asked by the Governor to fill that position, which is a statutorily appointed position. Mr. Carmichael's prime objective was to reduce the tremendous backlog and to review, thoroughly investigate and litigate more cases that come to the agency.

Chairman Brungardt closed the confirmation hearing.

Senator Vratil moved that the committee recommend to the full Senate the confirmation of John Carmichael to the Kansas Human Rights Commission. Senator Reitz seconded the motion.

Senator Brownlee moved a substitute motion that the committee deny a recommendation for confirmation of John Carmichael to the full Senate. Senator Ostmeyer seconded the motion. The vote was 4 - 4. The motion failed.

The original motion was voted on. <u>The vote was 4 - 4. The original motion failed</u>. No action or recommendation was taken by the committee on the confirmation.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:05 pm. The next scheduled committee meeting is May 1, 2008.

- 8. **Submission of Views:** I have submitted numerous letters to publications regarding political issues and have been interviewed by various electronic and print media over the past 30 years. - 2000 I was interviewed on a Nightline segment concerning the Right to Privacy.

- 10. **Opposition:** I do not know if persons or groups may unfairly attack my appointment.
- 11. **Miscellaneous:** For nearly 25 years I have practiced law in Wichita representing both plaintiffs and defendants including several cases and claims alleging governmental violation of civil rights, prohibited work place discrimination on the basis of sex, race, and disability, and retaliation for the exercise of protected rights. One of my undergraduate degrees is in Administration of Justice received at a time when racial profiling in law enforcement activities was a new topic on the horizon. At present I have no open cases involving the Human Rights Commission and do not intend to accept such cases if confirmed.

- 17. **Lobbying Activities:** I have not been retained to represent any person or organization in lobbying activities, however, as an individual I have communicated with numerous legislators concerning pending legislation. Generally, these communications have concerned bills of interest to the Kansas Trial Lawyers Association, the Wichita and Kansas Bar Associations, and reproductive rights organizations. I have participated in "Day on the Hill" or similar events hosted by

- these organizations. I know of no lobbying activity by either my spouse or myself concerning matters related to the Kansas Human Rights Commission.
- 18. **Regulated Activities**: My law firm in the past has performed work for the Kansas Insurance Commissioner and we occasionally receive attorneys' fees from the Kansas Workers Compensation Fund and the Kansas State Self Insurance Fund as a result of attorney fee awards under the Workers Compensation Act.

- 20. **Citations:** In about 1993 I was the subject of a complaint filed with the Kansas Lawyer Disciplinary Administrator by a former client, Robert Pitts, D.D.S. Following investigation the complaint was dismissed.

- 24. **Agency Proceedings:** In about 1983 Robert Pitts, D.D.S., through his attorney Fred Phelps, filed suit in the United States District Court for the District of Kansas alleging that I along with several owners and employees of my employer, Turner and Boisseau, Chrtd., as well as Attorney General Stephan, the Kansas Dental Board, the board's counsel, several insurance companies, and perhaps others, denied him constitutionally protected rights on account of his religion. The claim was dismissed by the District Court prior to trial and the Tenth Circuit Court of Appeals affirmed the dismissal.

- Other Litigation: My law firm commenced an action against a former employee and our then bank alleging check forgery by the employee and negligence by the bank in connection with embezzlement by the employee. I commenced an action against Best Buy alleging a violation of the Kansas Consumer Protection Act; the matter was "amicably resolved." I commenced an action against a contractor who failed to return a deposit for work not performed on my residence; the deposit was repaid prior to trial.
