MINUTES OF THE SENATE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Les Donovan at 10:20 A.M. on Friday, March 28, 2008 in Room 192-E of the Capitol.

Chairman Donovan opened the Confirmation Hearing for Colonel Terry L. Maple to be appointed Superintendent of the Kansas Highway Patrol. He welcomed Col. Maple and his family. Col. Maple spoke of his past accomplishments as a member of the Kansas Highway Patrol. He has been Assistant Superintendent of the Kansas Highway Patrol since 1999. His intent is to continue with the Patrol for another two and a half years. He stated he is proud to be a part of the Kansas Highway Patrol. (Attachment 1)

Sen. Wilson spoke about his experiences with Col. Maple, saying he has the ability to work well with everybody.

Sen. Goodwin stated Col. Maple has become a good friend during his years of work in the Capitol. She is honored to have him take this position.

Sen. Donovan asked Col. Maple to introduce his family and friends to the committee. Those attending the hearing were his wife, Donna; friend Tom Whitaker, Kansas Motor Carriers Association; wife's parents, Darrel and Virginia Hotchkiss; sister-in-law, Karen Smart with Mothers Against Drunk Driving; and sister-in-law, Penny Hotchkiss, a teacher with Allen County Community College.

Chairman Donovan said this is a proud day for all attending the hearing. He feels Col. Maple has worked in the Capitol and has a good understanding of the political part of the Superintendent's job. He thanked the Kansas Highway Patrol for its part in the passage of bills regarding teen driving, booster seats for young children, and seat belts for all.

Sen. Petersen noted the Highway Patrol's demonstration about seat belts is very helpful in educating students of the importance of usage of the belts. Col. Maple told the committee the Kansas Highway Patrol is partnering with Kansas Department of Transportation and the Department of Education to make this program even better.

Sen. Palmer told Col. Maple she appreciates him bringing himself forward to take this position.

Sen. Schmidt added that she has had the opportunity to work with Col. Maple in the past and he has her approval.

Sen. Goodwin moved "this Highway Patrol Guardian Angel" be approved as Superintendent of the Kansas Highway Patrol. Sen. Gilstrap and Sen. Wilson seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Donovan congratulated Col. Maple before closing the confirmation hearing. He then adjourned the meeting at 11:00. No other meetings are scheduled at this time.

Colonel Terry L. Maple Acting Superintendent Kansas Highway Patrol

Colonel Terry Maple currently serves as the Patrol's Acting Superintendent and oversees statewide operations of the agency. He has been a member of the Kansas Highway Patrol for over 28 years. He is a graduate of Burlingame High School, Allen County Community College and Washburn University. He and his wife of over 28 years, Donna, live in Topeka and have two grown daughters.

Maple joined the Patrol in June of 1979 and conducted road patrol duties in and around Shawnee County until 1984, when he was promoted to Pilot and transferred to the Patrol's Aircraft Unit in Topeka. In 1987 he transferred to the Patrol's General Headquarters and was assigned to the Research and Planning section where he served as Special Assistant to the Superintendent, as State Public Information Officer and as legislative liaison. In 1988, he was promoted to Sergeant and then to Lieutenant in 1996. In May of 1997, Maple transferred to the Kansas Turnpike where he assumed command of Troop G. He was promoted to Captain in 1998 while serving as Troop G Commander. In March of 1999, Maple was appointed Lieutenant Colonel and began serving as the agency's Assistant Superintendent and second in command. On February 1, 2008 Governor Kathleen Sebelius appointed him Acting Superintendent of the Patrol.

In 1998, Terry was selected to attend and completed the Leadership Greater Topeka training course sponsored by the Greater Topeka Area Chamber of Commerce. Leadership Greater Topeka brings together a broad cross section of both acknowledged and aspiring leaders for an annual community leadership-training course.

In 2000, he was nominated and selected to attend the FBI National Academy in Quantico, VA where he completed an extensive advanced management-training curriculum for police executives sponsored by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. He currently serves as President of the Executive Board for the Kansas/Western MO Chapter of the FBI National Academy Associates. He is also a charter member of the FBI's Kansas City Division Counter Terrorism Executive Board.

Maple has been active in the State and Provincial Division of the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP). In January 2008, he was re-appointed to a three-year term as a State and Provincial Division representative to the IACP Aviation Committee.

He has also served as a board member of the HELP INC., (Heavy Vehicle Electronic License Plate, Inc.), board of Directors since 2003. HELP INC. is a non-profit partnership between motor carriers and government agencies. Help's mission is to develop and deploy advanced technology systems that create a cooperative operating and regulatory environment, which improves the efficient and safe movement of commercial vehicles and the performance of highway systems.

In 2007 the Administrator of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration appointed Terry to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Advisory Council. The 15 member nationwide panel makes recommendations to the Administrator on key highway safety issues involving commercial motor carriers.

Terry is also an active member of the Kansas Peace Officers Association, Kansas Association of Chiefs of Police, Kansas Sheriffs Association, the Kansas City Metropolitan Chiefs of Police and the Johnson County Chiefs of Police. He serves on selected committees of the various associations including the Awards for Valor Selection committee of the Kansas Association of Chiefs of Police.

In the community, Terry has served as Site Council Chairman at Tecumseh South Elementary School, as a District Advisory Council member in Shawnee Heights, USD # 450, as a member of the United Way Allocation Committee, as a Project Topeka Agency Coordinator and as a Board member of the Shawnee County Girls Softball Association. He is currently active as a member of the Kansas Attorney General's Amber Alert Committee, the Project Safe Neighborhood Grant Selection Committee for the US Attorney for Kansas and as a member of the Kansas Juvenile Justice Authority State Juvenile Crime Enforcement Coalition.

Colonel Terry L. Maple Superintendent Kansas Highway Patrol

Colonel Terry Maple currently serves as the Patrol's Superintendent and oversees statewide operations of the agency. He has been a member of the Kansas Highway Patrol for over 28 years. He is a graduate of Burlingame High School, Allen County Community College and Washburn University. He and his wife of over 28 years, Donna, live in Topeka and have two grown daughters.

Maple joined the Patrol in June of 1979 and conducted road patrol duties in and around Shawnee County until 1984, when he was promoted to Pilot and transferred to the Patrol's Aircraft Unit in Topeka. In 1987 he transferred to the Patrol's General Headquarters and was assigned to the Research and Planning section where he served as Special Assistant to the Superintendent, as State Public Information Officer and as legislative liaison. In 1988, he was promoted to Sergeant and then to Lieutenant in 1996. In May of 1997, Maple transferred to the Kansas Turnpike where he assumed command of Troop G. He was promoted to Captain in 1998 while serving as Troop G Commander. In March of 1999, Maple was appointed Lieutenant Colonel and began serving as the agency's Assistant Superintendent and second in command. On February 1, 2008 Governor Kathleen Sebelius appointed him Superintendent of the Patrol.

In 1998, Terry was selected to attend and completed the Leadership Greater Topeka training course sponsored by the Greater Topeka Area Chamber of Commerce. Leadership Greater Topeka brings together a broad cross section of both acknowledged and aspiring leaders for an annual community leadership-training course.

In 2000, he was nominated and selected to attend the FBI National Academy in Quantico, VA where he completed an extensive advanced management-training curriculum for police executives sponsored by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. He currently serves as President of the Executive Board for the Kansas/Western MO Chapter of the FBI National Academy Associates. He is also a charter member of the FBI's Kansas City Division Counter Terrorism Executive Board.

Maple has been active in the State and Provincial Division of the International Association of Chiefs of Police (IACP). In January 2008, he was re-appointed to a three-year term as a State and Provincial Division representative to the IACP Aviation Committee.

He has also served as a board member of the HELP INC., (Heavy Vehicle Electronic License Plate, Inc.), board of Directors since 2003. HELP INC. is a non-profit partnership between motor carriers and government agencies. Help's mission is to develop and deploy advanced technology systems that create a cooperative operating and regulatory environment, which improves the efficient and safe movement of commercial vehicles and the performance of highway systems.

In 2007 the Administrator of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration appointed Terry to the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Advisory Council. The 15 member nationwide panel makes recommendations to the Administrator on key highway safety issues involving commercial motor carriers.

Terry is also an active member of the Kansas Peace Officers Association, Kansas Association of Chiefs of Police, Kansas Sheriffs Association, the Kansas City Metropolitan Chiefs of Police and the Johnson County Chiefs of Police. He serves on selected committees of the various associations including the Awards for Valor Selection committee of the Kansas Association of Chiefs of Police.

In the community, Terry has served as Site Council Chairman at Tecumseh South Elementary School, as a District Advisory Council member in Shawnee Heights, USD # 450, as a member of the United Way Allocation Committee, as a Project Topeka Agency Coordinator and as a Board member of the Shawnee County Girls Softball Association. He is currently active as a member of the Kansas Attorney General's Amber Alert Committee, the Project Safe Neighborhood Grant Selection Committee for the US Attorney for Kansas and as a member of the Kansas Juvenile Justice Authority State Juvenile Crime Enforcement Coalition.
