1. (9rs1262) Creates the agriculture land conservation program.
2. (9rs1204) Drinking water supply lakes, authorizing fees.
3. (9rs1197) Creating the land preservation partner program & fund.
4. (9rs1189) Providing insurance coverage for telemedicine.
5. (9rs1211) Workers compensation relating to firefighters' exposure to certain health conditions.
6. (9rs1264) Relating to reimbursement for telemedicine and telehealth monitoring.
- ~~X~~ (9rs1355) Relating to land uses adjacent to military installations.
8. (9rs1248) Relating to veterans, post-traumatic stress disorder and sentencing guidelines.
9. (9rs1253) Repeals the statutory requirement for one judge in each county.
10. (9RS1333) Requests the Kansas Supreme court to study the Kansas court system.
