By Committee on Ways and Means

AN ACT concerning compensation and expenses of legislators for a period of time during the 2011 regular session of the legislature.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of K.S.A. 46-137a, and amendments thereto, during the 2011 regular session of the legislature, no member of the legislature shall receive for any day on which the legislature is in session subsequent to May 12, 2011, the per diem compensation and subsistence allowances provided for in subsections (a) and (b) of K.S.A. 46-137a, and amendments thereto.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
