SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 109

As Amended by House Committee on Local Government

Brief*

SB 109 authorizes any city or any township to donate and convey to the county lands or property which it has acquired for cemetery purposes or which is now being used as a cemetery. The donation and conveyance shall be made by the passage of an ordinance by the governing body of the city or by resolution of the township board. The board of county commissioners of any county may accept the donation and conveyance by the adoption of a resolution.

The House Committee amendments were technical and clarifying in nature.

Background

A proponent said some smaller townships and cities do not have the resources to adequately maintain cemeteries.

The bill has no fiscal impact on the state.
