#### SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 162

## As Recommended by Senate Committee on Assessment and Taxation

### Brief\*

SB 162 would reenact for the 2003-2004 and 2004-2005 school years (property tax years 2003 and 2004) the 20-mill mandatory school district general fund property tax levy and the \$20,000 residential exemption therefrom.

# Background

According to the school finance property tax model developed and maintained by the Legislative Research Department, failure to reenact the levy and residential exemption would reduce local effort for purposes of the school finance formula by \$257.7 million in FY 2004; \$438.3 million in FY 2005; and \$455.7 million in FY 2006.

The Governor's Budget is based on the assumption that the mill levy and residential exemption would in fact be renewed at these levels.
