SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2189

As Recommended by House Committee on Transportation

Brief*

HB 2189 would change the registration expiration date of vehicles registered to operate at 16,000 pounds or more to the last day of February each year rather than the current date of February 15. The date of enforcement of the registration would also change from February 15, to March 1 of each year. The bill would require the Department of Revenue to issue a February decal for these vehicles to correspond with the statutory grace period.

Background

Representative Ballou testified in favor of the bill before the House Transportation Committee. The Wyandotte Country Treasurer also spoke in favor of the bill. The Director of Vehicles provided background information to the Committee. No one presented testimony in opposition to the bill.

According to the Department of Revenue, any fiscal effect that results from the passage of the bill would be absorbed within existing resources.
