### **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2202**

# As Recommended by House Committee on Local Government

## **Brief\***

HB 2202 amends a law dealing with filing of plats in cities of the second and third class. It allows all owners of land which is to be dedicated to a city for a public purpose to furnish a title insurance policy for the land as an alternative to submitting an abstract of title.

## **Background**

Representative Gatewood and a representative of the League of Kansas Municipalities testified in favor of the bill. Proponents said the bill permits the use of title insurance as a means of establishing good title for land proposed to be dedicated to a city for a public purpose. The use of title insurance rather than an abstract of title is common in many parts of the state.

The bill has no fiscal effect.
