SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2204

As Recommended by House Committee on Local Government

Brief*

HB 2204 amends the city and county planning and zoning law dealing with the membership of the city planning commission when the city decides to plan, zone, or administer subdivision regulations outside the city limits. The bill adds to the current provision that requires at least two members of the planning commission reside outside of but within three miles of the city to allow these persons who own property within the three-mile area and who reside within the unincorporated area to serve on the city planning commission.

Background

The bill was supported by Representative Melvin Minor, who said the issue was brought to him by a constituent who owns property within the three-mile ring of a city but resides 400 feet outside of this area. The bill would allow him and others to serve on the city planning commission.

The bill has no fiscal impact.
