SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2243

As Recommended by House Committee on Commerce and Labor

Brief*

HB 2243 provides for computerized tests to be given to certified public accountants instead of paper and pencil tests. The Board of Accountancy will have rule and regulation authority for implementing the provisions governing examinations. Additionally, the Board may contract with third parties to perform administrative services regarding examinations.

Provisions regarding the education requirement for admission to examinations will sunset on January 1, 2004.

The bill is placed on the consent calendar.

Background

A conferee from the Board of Accountancy expressed support for the bill.

The fiscal note was not available when the bill passed out of committee.
