SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2310

As Recommended by House Committee on Appropriations

Brief*

HB 2310 would allow the Superintendent of the Topeka Juvenile Correctional Facility to appoint an unclassified deputy superintendent and attorney.

Background

Current law require all staff at the juvenile correctional facilities to be members of the classified service. The exceptions to this requirement are facility superintendents, who are appointed by the Commissioner of the Juvenile Justice Authority, and physicians, who are appointed by the facility superintendents. These appointees are required by law to be members of the unclassified service.

The Acting Commissioner of the Juvenile Justice Authority testified in support of the bill.

The fiscal note indicates no fiscal impact.
