SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2339

As Amended by House Committee on Education

Brief*

HB 2339 as amended would require compulsory school attendance beginning with kindergarten. In addition, any child who is under the age of six years, but who is enrolled in school, would be subject to the compulsory attendance requirements. Under current law, compulsory school attendance begins with first grade and any child who is under the age of seven years, and enrolled, is subject to the act.

Background

Representative Ward Loyd testified as a proponent of the bill and no opponents testified nor provided written testimony. The House Committee on Education amended the bill by lowering the compulsory attendance requirements from seven years to six years of age.

The Division of the Budget indicates that the bill would have a negligible fiscal impact.
