# SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 28

## As Recommended by House Committee on <u>Judiciary</u>

### Brief\*

The House Committee deleted the prior provisions of SB 28 and proposes House Sub. for SB 28 which expands the list of those professions that are authorized to form professional corporations by adding a licensed physician assistant and licensed occupation therapists to the current list of professional services.

Another provision of the bill deals with limitations on professional corporation ownership through the adoption of rules and regulations by the Board of Health Arts to limit the percentage of ownership when a licensed physician assistant or licensed occupational therapist forms a professional corporation in combination with other professional services.

### Background

The original bill was recommended by a subcommittee group of a Kansas Bar Association study group formed to study changes needed for the general corporation code and by the Kansas Bar Association Board of Governors.

The bill has no fiscal impact.
