SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 321

As Amended by Senate Committee on Judiciary

Brief*

SB 321 amends the Code of Procedure for Municipal Courts to expand the powers of a municipal judge to hold a person in contempt and to clarify an appeal of a contempt finding is to be tried by the district court. Language stating contempt must be committed in court or be for failure to obey process issued by a municipal judge is deleted.

The Senate Committee amendments were clarifying.
