SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 387

As Amended by House Select Committee on Kansas Security

Brief*

SB 387 would amend the Kansas Interlocal Cooperation Act to add to the list of items for cooperative effort: public security, including intelligence, antiterrorism and disaster recovery, and public safety and emergency preparedness.

The Senate Committee added public safety and everyday preparedness.

The House Select Committee on Kansas Security amended KSA 75-3717 to direct the Division of Budget to create a listing of sources and amounts of federal funds received or budgeted by all state agencies for the purposes of homeland security, including administrative and aid to local unit costs.

Background

The bill was supported by Senator Jay Emler who said the bill would clarify the ability of local governments to enter into cooperative efforts in anti terrorism and other public security areas. The bill was also supported by a private consulting firm involved in security matters.

The provisions amended by the House Select Committee on Kansas Security had no opponents.
