SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 423

As Amended by Senate Committee on
Judiciary

Brief*

SB 423 repeals a provision of the Code of Civil Procedure dealing with wage garnishments which currently prohibits wage garnishments for assigned accounts.

The Senate Committee amendment was technical.

Background

The bill was supported by the Kansas Credit Attorney's Association. A proponent noted bank garnishment could be used against a debtor for assigned accounts but not wage garnishment.

The bill has no fiscal impact on the state.
