SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 533

As Amended by Senate Committee of the Whole

Brief*

SB 533 concerns the Kansas Racing and Gaming Commission. As amended, the bill provides that the Attorney General shall appoint, with the approval of the Executive Director of the State Gaming Agency, an additional Assistant Attorney General. Current law provides that the Attorney General shall appoint, with the approval of the Racing and Gaming Commission, two Assistant Attorney General positions to assist the Commission.

The original version of the bill would have increased from two to three the number of Assistant Attorney General positions appointed, subject to the approval of the Commission.

The Senate Committee of the Whole amendment is technical.

Background

The original version of the bill was recommended by the Senate Committee on Ways and Means as a result of a subcommittee recommendation that an additional Assistant Attorney General be authorized.

The Executive Director of the State Gaming Agency appeared in support of SB 533.

The fiscal note indicates a fiscal effect of from \$56,552 to \$57,552. These expenses are accounted for in *The FY 2005 Governor's Budget Report.*
