# **SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2717**

## As Amended by House Committee on Health and Human Services

#### Brief\*

HB 2717, as amended, amends the law regarding crematories. The bill requires the crematory operator in charge of a licensed crematory to hold a Kansas funeral director's or embalmer's license, unless the crematory receives only dead human bodies for cremation through licensed funeral establishments or branch funeral establishments.

The House Committee amendment clarifies that the original bill was not intended to require all crematories to be under the supervision of a licensed funeral director or embalmer; but only those that are not conducting immediate cremations and might hold bodies for an extended period of time.

### **Background**

HB 2717 was requested by the Kansas Funeral Directors and Embalmers Association, whose representative explained that the bill represents the best way to assure that dead human bodies are properly cared for and that the health and safety of the public is protected.

The fiscal note prepared by the Division of the Budget indicates passage of the bill will have no fiscal effect.
