SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2793

As Amended by House Committee on Local Government

Brief*

HB 2793 would amend a drainage district law to delete language which requires a drainage district board to declare the necessity for a continued mill levy of not to exceed five mills, every four years by resolution and makes this resolution subject to a protest petition and election. The bill also provides that the drainage district board may raise the mill levy if the qualified electors of the drainage district approve the increase.

Background

The bill was supported by Representatives Ward Loyd and Larry Powell, and representatives of Drainage District No. 1 of Finney County.
