SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2908

As Recommended by House Committee on Commerce and Labor

Brief*

HB 2908 deals with the membership of the State Workforce Investment Board (SWIB) and local workforce investment boards as follows:

- ! Membership on the SWIB will include:
 - " a representative of nonprofit agencies and organizations and public bodies providing services to persons seeking employment through the Older Kansas Employment Program;
 - " a representative of Area Agencies on Aging; and
 - " a representative of the Department of Commerce.
- ! Membership on a local WIB will include:
 - " a representative of nonprofit agencies and organizations and public bodies providing services to persons seeking employment through the Older Kansas Employment Program;
 - " a representative of Area Agencies on Aging served by the local WIB; and
 - " an older Kansan who has received assistance from a nonprofit agency or organization or public boy providing services through the older Kansas Employment Program.

In addition, each local WIB will establish an advisory committee to review the WIB's service plan and performance regarding services provided to older Kansans seeking employment.

Background
