**CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT BRIEF
HOUSE BILL NO. 2283**

As Agreed to April 2, 2007

Brief*

HB 2283 amends the law regarding security interests in vehicles and manufactured homes to clarify that a security interest is perfected in a vehicle when the surrendered title has been delivered and the application has been submitted, with the required fee, to the Division of Motor Vehicles.

Conference Committee Action

The Conference Committee agreed to the version of the bill that cures the conflict in KSA 8-135.

Background
