SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2190

As Recommended by House Committee on
Judiciary

Brief*

HB 2190 would provide authority for the Secretary of the Department of Corrections, or the Secretary's designee, to dismiss charges that a released inmate has violated the conditions of release and may order the released inmate to remain on parole, conditional release, or post-release supervision.

Other changes are technical in nature.

Background

Tim Madden, on behalf of the Secretary of the Department of Corrections, expressed support for the bill.
