SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON HOUSE BILL NO. 2001

As Recommended by House Committee on
Education

Brief*

HB 2001 would allow a student in the custody of the Secretary of Social and Rehabilitation Services or the Commissioner of the Juvenile Justice Authority and who is enrolled in the Atchison School District (USD 409) to be counted as two pupils. The affected students would have to be housed and receiving educational services at the youth residential center located on the grounds of the former Atchison Juvenile Correctional Facility for the district to qualify at the higher rate.

In school year 2009-2010, the bill would authorize a student enrollment of two times the licensed capacity of the youth residential center; for school years thereafter, student enrollment would be two times the actual number of students at the center.

Background

Proponents of the bill were Representative Jerry Henry and Dr. Susan Myers, Superintendent of Atchison USD 409.

The Division of the Budget estimated the bill would cost an additional \$151,928 in general state aid in Fiscal Year 2010.
