SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 408

As Amended by Senate Committee on Transportation

Brief*

SB 408 would clarify the type of facility at which a county treasurer would be allowed to charge up to \$5 for any motor vehicle registered at that facility. The bill would require that a county have at least one registration facility at which the fee would not be charged and that the fee not be charged at a registration facility within the county courthouse or administration office used as the primary location for the county treasurer's operations.

Background

The Johnson County Treasurer and a representative of the Kansas Association of Counties presented testimony in favor of the bill. No testimony was presented in opposition to the bill.

The Senate Committee on Transportation amended the bill to require that the fee not be charged at one or more of a county's registration facilities.

According to the fiscal note, the bill would have no fiscal effect on Department of Revenue operations. The fiscal note also states that the effects on counties would depend on actions taken by county treasurers and cannot be estimated.
