SUPPLEMENTAL NOTE ON SENATE BILL NO. 575

As Recommended by Senate Committee on
Ways and Means

Brief*

SB 575 would amend current law to adjust the distribution of the Special City and County Highway Fund payments to cities and counties from FY 2011 to FY 2015. The bill would reduce quarterly Special City and County Highway Fund payments over five years from the 100 counties that were overpaid from FY 2000 to FY 2009, and redistribute \$11.1 million to the five underpaid counties (Barton, Butler, Douglas, Leavenworth, and Shawnee). The numbers in the bill reflect amounts that would be deducted for five years from the quarterly distributions of the Special City and County Highway Fund payments for each of the 100 counties.

Background

SB 575 was introduced in the Senate Committee on Ways and Means. There were no conferees. No fiscal note was provided. No State General Fund dollars are impacted by this bill.
