RE: Oppose House Bill 2437

Dear Representative Rahjes and Committee Members,

I am a member of the Kansas Pet Professionals and hold a USDA class A license with USDA APHIS. I participate in educational opportunities and competitions in AKC events, as well as those hosted by the Kansas Pet Professionals.

While I am not a resident of the state of Kansas, decisions made by your committee impact my life.

I regularly participate in dog related activities across state lines. I am writing to ask that you oppose House Bill 2437 as written regarding the Kansas Pet Animal Act. The Kansas Pet Professionals has requested you to consider many amendments that should show that there are many more things to discuss and establish than the few changes the department has introduced to you.

Many items introduced in House Bill 2437 can be addressed within regulation and would allow more latitude for the program and the industry. The program and act were developed by Kansas breeders, for breeders and this is the second year that the Kansas Pet Animal Advisory Board has not be made aware of legislation being submitted by the department until afterwards.

Until the department and program can be transparent and communicate with all industries this Act involves, no legislation should be passed. The department and program have damaged the confidence of the industry in them.

I ask that you oppose House Bill 2437 as written and consider the requested amendments.
