

HB 2167 Brief

HB 2167 amends the campaign finance act to:

1. Prohibit the use of any political funds that have been collected by a candidate or candidate committee and were subject to the reporting requirements of the campaign finance act for the campaign of a candidate for a federal elective office.
2. Regulate and limit the use of cryptocurrency. Contributions shall not to exceed \$100 per year, cryptocurrency shall be converted into United States currency immediately upon receipt and the payment of such funds must be from a United States based payment processor who can identify the name and address of each contributor.
