

HB 2422--Brief

HB 2422 would eliminate requirements that a chief inspector appointed by the State Fire Marshal must have at least five years of experience in the construction, installation, repair, operations, or inspection of boilers, steam generators, super-heaters, or pressure vessels and that they hold certain endorsements issued by the National Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Inspectors (NBBI). The bill would also eliminate requirements that a deputy inspector appointed by the State Fire Marshal must have education, training, or work experience in the construction, installation, repair, operation, or inspection of boilers or pressure vessels totaling two years and hold an in-service commission issued by the NBBI.
