

**Proponent Testimony for SB 28 – Refunding Group-Funded Pools** 

March 8, 2023

Chairman Sutton and Members of the Committee,

Thank you for the opportunity to testify in support of Senate Bill 28.

Senate Bill 28 repeals K.S.A. 12-2623 and K.S.A. 44-587 and amends K.S.A. 44-588. These statutes outline assessments, or fees, set by the Insurance Commissioner to cover the necessary costs of administration and supervision of group-funded pools and group-funded workers' compensation pools. The Department has long determined this assessment is not necessary, and since at least 2015 Kansas group-funded pools have not been assessed this supervisory fee. In turn, the Group-Funded Pools Fee Fund of \$40,528 and the Group-Funded Workers' Compensation Pools Fee Fund of \$112,719 have been sitting idle.

Senate Bill 28 repeals this assessment and discontinues these two funds. The bill transfers the balance of the two funds into a new fund known as the Group-Funded Pools Refund Fund with a sum of \$153,247. This balance will be distributed to the 17 operating pools in Kansas on a pro-rata basis, based on premium taxes paid by each pool for FY 2022.

Senate Bill 28 passed the Senate Committee of the Whole with a vote of 39-1.
