Subject: House Bill 2382 – Bill Brief

House Bill 2382 would enact the school district board of education member free speech and transparency act which would:

- Require school districts to publish the names and email addresses of the local school board members on the school district's website and require KSDE to maintain a composite list of all such information on the KSDE website.
- Make records that are made, maintained or kept by a school board member on a
 member's private electronic device subject to disclosure under the open meetings act if
 the record concerns the business, functions, activities, programs or operations of the
 board of education. Section 2 of HB 2382 would amend K.S.A. 45-217 of the open
 records act to effectuate this revision.
- Expressly authorize a member of a board of education to add discussion topics and items to the board's meeting agenda prior to or at the start of any board meeting.
- Prohibit the school board from restricting or prohibiting another board member's questions or discussions with any person who presents public comment or testimony.
- Require each school district board of education meeting to include a public comment portion of the meeting.
- Require the appropriate staff of a school district to fulfill any request for information regarding the school district made by a board member.
- Require every board member to disclose communications that were intended to be sent or were addressed to the entire board.
 - HB 2382 would take effect upon publication in the statute book on July 1, 2023.
